Content: The Great Basin Science Delivery Project and the Nevada Partners for Conservation and Development are hosting a two-day workshop, "Vegetation Resilience, the Role of the Perennial Herbaceous Understory, and Intact Sagebrush," in Winnemucca, NV on Tuesday and Wednesday, 24-25 May 2011. This workshop will address the importance of maintaining intact sagebrush communities in the face of multiple ecological stressors, and provide some restoration techniques and treatment results.
