- Small-plot herbicide treatments in cheatgrass (rate, timing, & adjuvant trials)
- Sagebrush transplants in native herbaceous post-burn site

1:30 pm – Sheep Creek field site

- Small-plot herbicide treatments in cheatgrass (rate & timing trials)
- Large-plot herbicide treatments in cheatgrass (rate & timing demonstration)
